INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SIMPLIFICATION AND HARMONIZATION OF CUSTOMS PROCEDURES (AS AMENDED)

(done at Kyoto on 18 May 1973, amended on 3 February 2006)

NOTIFICATION BY JORDAN*

The Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan has notified the Secretary General, by a communication received on 8 December 2006, that Jordan has acceded to the International Convention on the simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures (as amended), done at Kyoto on 18 May 1973 and amended on 3 February 2006, and accepted, with reservations, the following Specific Annexes/Chapters:

- Specific Annex A - Arrival of goods in a Customs territory/

- Chapter 1 Formalities prior to the lodgement of the Goods declaration (reservations against Recommended Practices 10, 11, 12 and 14)
