INSTRUMENT OF ACCESSION TO THE REVISED KYOTO CONVENTION - INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SIMPLIFICATION AND HARMONIZATION OF CUSTOMS PROCEDURES (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS the Revised Kyoto Convention – International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures (as amended), was done at Brussels on 26 June 1999;

AND WHEREAS Article 8 (2) of the said Convention provides that after 30 June 1974, it shall be open for accession;

AND WHEREAS Article 19 (1) of the said Convention provides that instruments of accession shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of the Council;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of the Republic of Namibia, having considered and approved the above-mentioned Convention on 9 October 2003 in terms of Article 63 (2) (e) of the Namibian Constitution, hereby formally accedes to the said Convention and undertakes to perform and carry out faithfully the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I HIDIPO HAMUTENYA, MP and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Namibia, have signed and sealed this Instrument of Accession.
