



**International Convention on the simplification and harmonization  
of Customs procedures  
(as amended)**

(done at Brussels on 26 June 1999)\*

**NOTIFICATION BY NEW ZEALAND**

On 7 July 2000, the New Zealand acceding to the Protocol of amendment to the International Convention on the simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures, done at Brussels on 26 June 1999, and accepted:

- **Specific Annex A – Arrival of goods in a Customs territory/**  
Chapter 1 – Formalities prior to the lodgement of the Goods declaration
