***INSTRUMENT OF ACCESSION TO THE PROTOCOL OF  
AMENDMENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION  
ON THE SIMPLIFICATION AND HARMONIZATION  
OF CUSTOMS PROCEDURES (26TH JUNE, 1999)***

**Whereas** the Protocol of Amendment to the International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures was opened for signature at Brussels on the 26th of June, 1999;

**And Whereas** it is provided in Article 3 of the Protocol that any Party to the Convention may express its consent to be bound by this Protocol by acceding to it;

**And Whereas** the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria has by a decision duly reached in accordance with its Constitutional provisions, agreed to accede to the aforesaid Protocol (EXCEPTING THE SPECIFIC ANNEXES);

**Now Therefore**, I, DR. GOODLUCK EBELE JONATHAN, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, do hereby accede to the Protocol of Amendment to the International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures.
