## INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

**WHEREAS** the Protocol amending the International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures, was adopted on 26<sup>th</sup> June 1999 by the States Parties to the Convention; and

**WHEREAS** the said Protocol has been signed on behalf of the government of the Republic of Uganda; and

**WHEREAS** in compliance with Section 3 of the Ratification of Treaties Act 1998 and the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda, Cabinet examined, considered and approved ratification of the said Protocol;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, JAMES FRANCIS WAPAKABULO**, Third Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uganda, do hereby declare that the Government of the Republic of Uganda ratifies the Protocol amending the International Convention on the Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures and undertake to faithfully perform the stipulations contained therein.
