### ✓ Relationship between AEO and EORI at the EU level

AEO certificates	1.921,00	4.354,00	10.680,00	12.346,00
EORI number	2.378.108,00	2.528.089,00	3.112.042,00	3.333.460,00
Rate	0,08%	0,17%	0,34%	0,37%

# AEO studies – EU initiatives

## ✓ Involvement of AEOs in overall EU trade

Total involvement of AEO as percentage of the total number of customs declarations was

- 15% in 2009 (first year when the survey was carried out) -
- 20% in 2010,
- 44% in 2011, and
- 50% in 2012 (import and export) and 42% for transit
