- Improvement of synergy between Postal, Border and Aviation security

- Data quality challenges; requirements, capacity, language, data logistics
- Compatibility of IT systems between Post, Customs and Carriers

- Trying to meet the regulatory needs of customs, security and air carriers



- Mutual acceptance and agreement of data requirements between all entities of the supply chain
- Reasonable risk based approach by all parties
- Better understanding of the rules and requirements of the postal model to ensure a smooth transition of advanced data requirements
- Clearer understanding of the evolving postal model and its capabilities
- Continue to refine current models and study results from the work being done in Canada (Canada Post, Canada Border Services Agency) this year
