

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS
March 17, 2020 № 149

On introduction of a temporary ban on export of certain goods from the Republic of Belarus

In accordance with [articles 29](#) and [47](#) of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union dated May 29, 2014, [subparagraph 1.5](#) of [paragraph 1](#) of the Decree of the President of the Republic of Belarus dated April 5, 2016 № 124 «On State Regulation of Foreign Trade Activity», Council of Ministers of the Republic of Belarus has decided:

1. To establish a temporary ban on the export of Belarusian goods listed in the Annex, regardless of their country of origin, including when placed under the customs procedure of export, temporary export, outward processing and reexport (hereinafter – customs procedures).

Abovementioned temporary ban also applies to goods placed under the customs procedure prior to the entry into force of this Resolution and the actual export of which from the Republic of Belarus in accordance with these customs procedures carried out after the entry into force of this Resolution.

2. The effect of [paragraph 1](#) of the present Resolution does not apply to the export of goods, including while placing them under the customs procedures:

for the provision of humanitarian assistance for international foreign states on the basis of Decisions of the Government of the Republic of Belarus;

by individuals for personal use.

3. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the prescribed manner should:

notify the Eurasian Economic Commission on the introduction of a temporary ban, referred to in [paragraph 1](#) of this Resolution;

submit to the Eurasian Economic Commission a proposal for usage of the measures equal to ones established in [paragraph 1](#) of this Resolution, by other member states of the Eurasian Economic Union.

4. This Resolution shall enter into force on the day of its official publication, except for [paragraph 3](#) which shall take effect from the date of adoption of this Resolution, and is valid until June 1, 2020.

The effect of this Resolution applies to the relations arising from the March 16, 2020.
