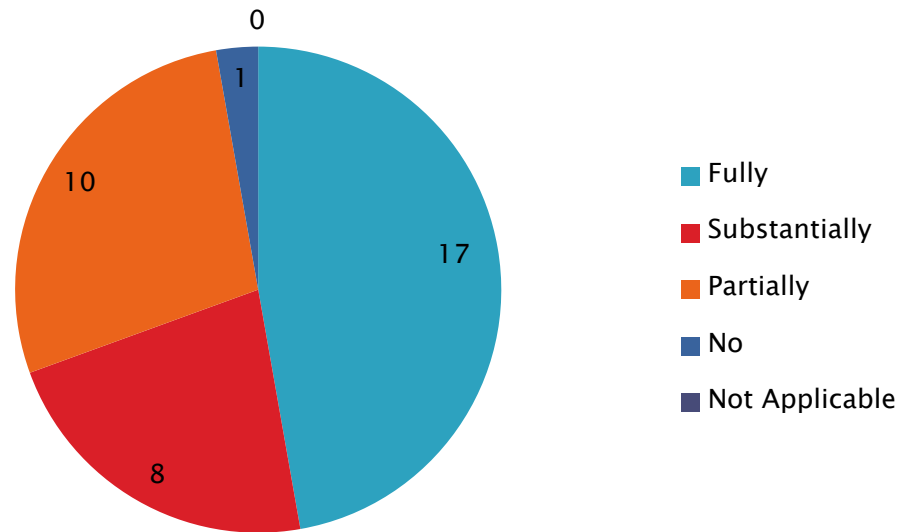
- ▶ Objectives of self assessments were to determine overall compliance level with TFA

- ▶ 36 measures were considered

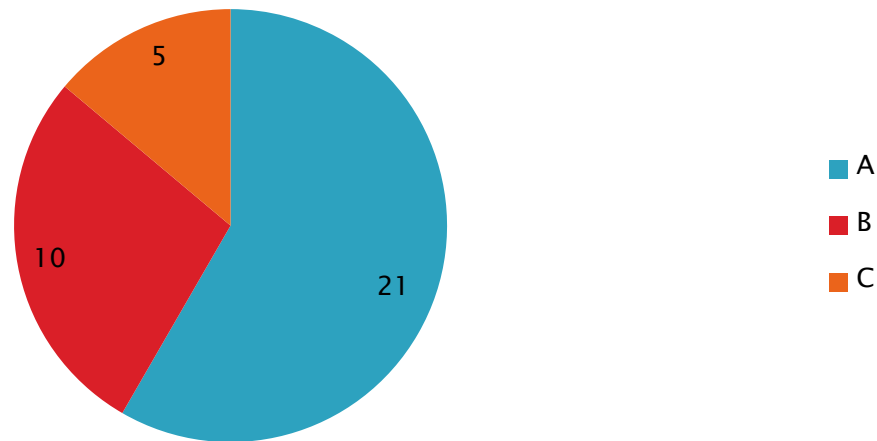
Level of Compliance with Measures

A = we can implement when Trade Facilitation Agreement enters into force

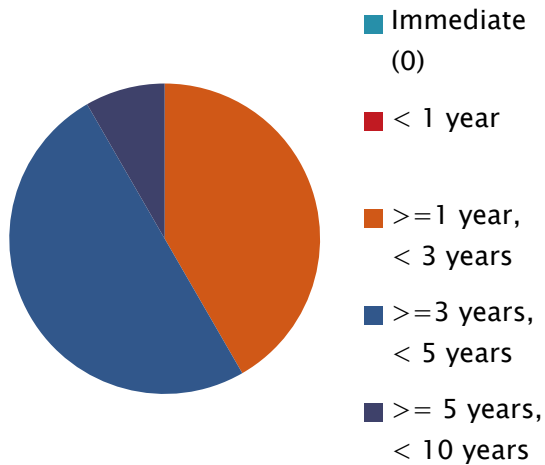
B = we will need additional time to implement

C = we will need additional time and technical assistance to implement

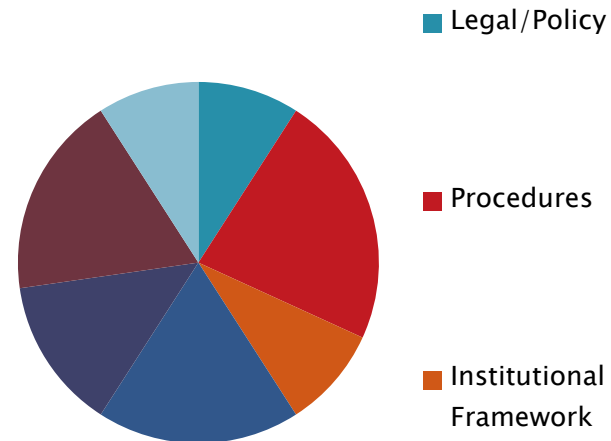
