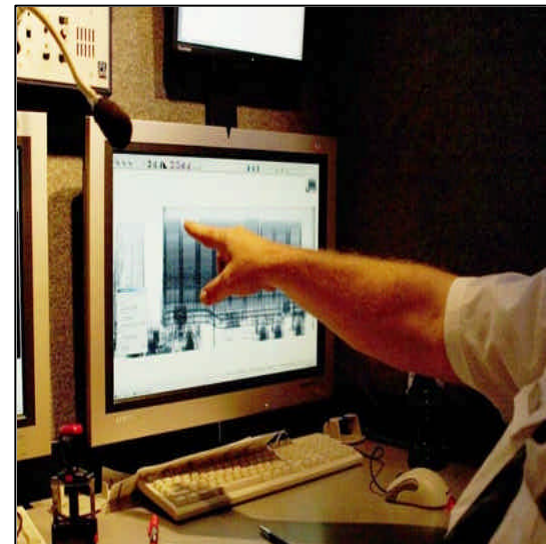

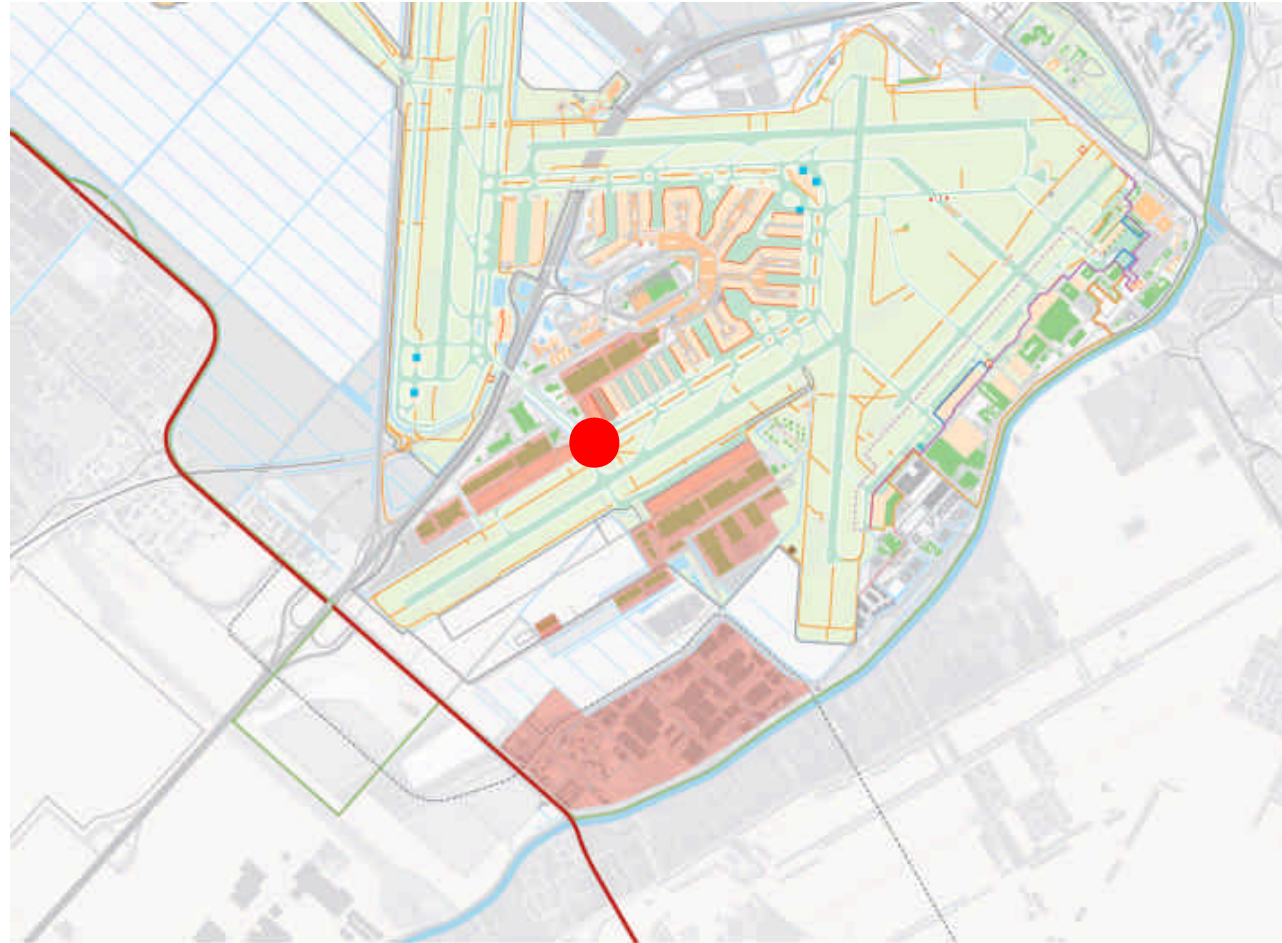

 - Aviation Security

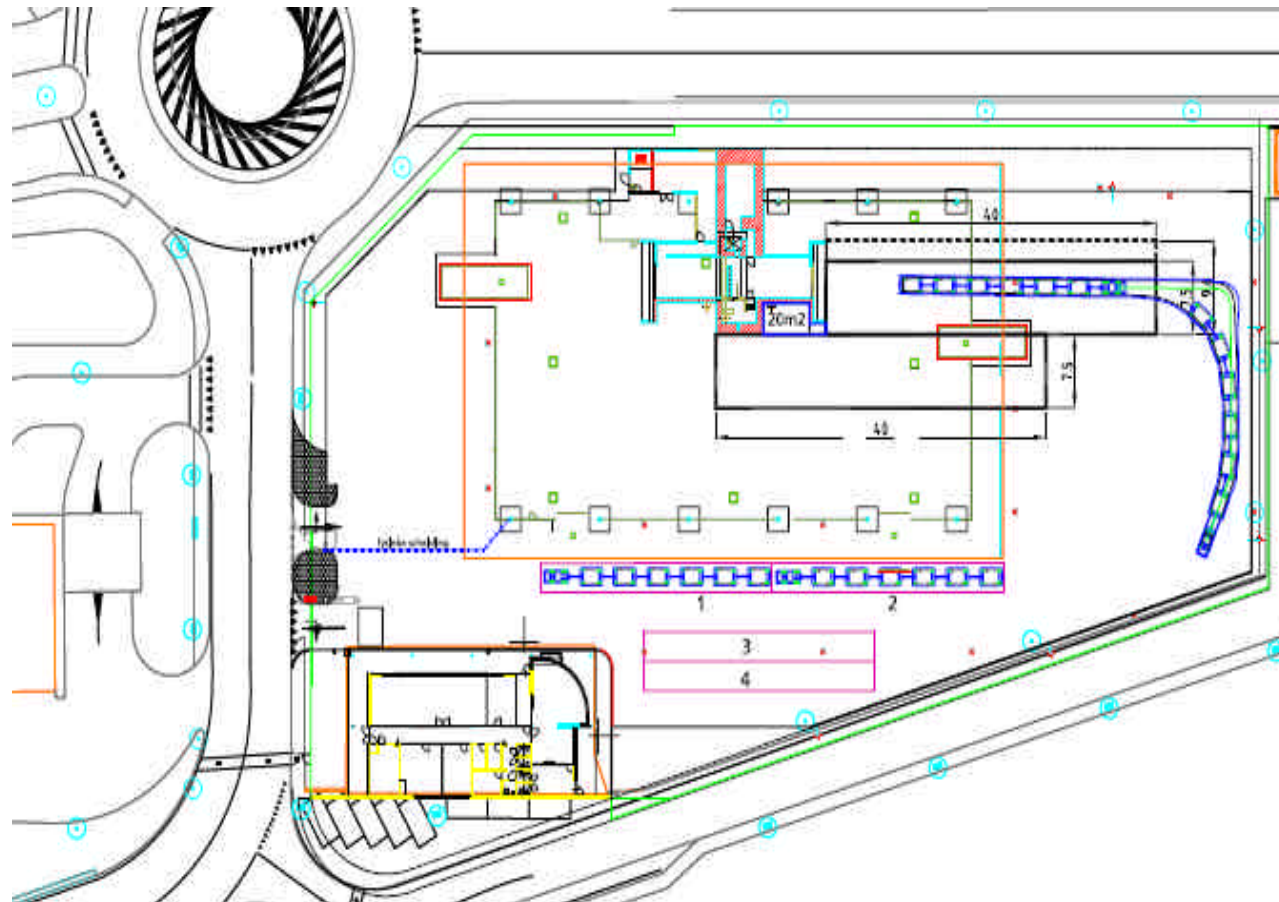

Location of Cargo Checkpoint



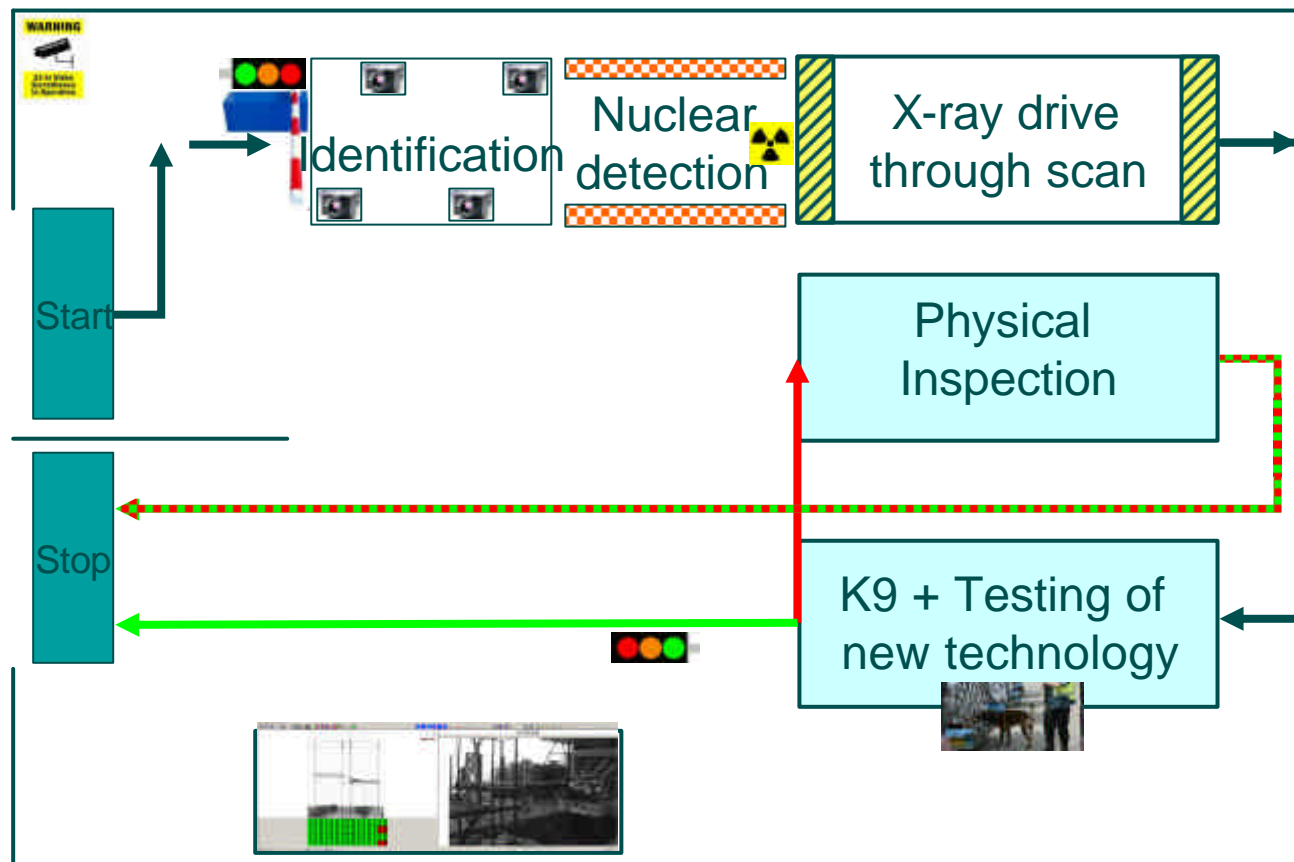

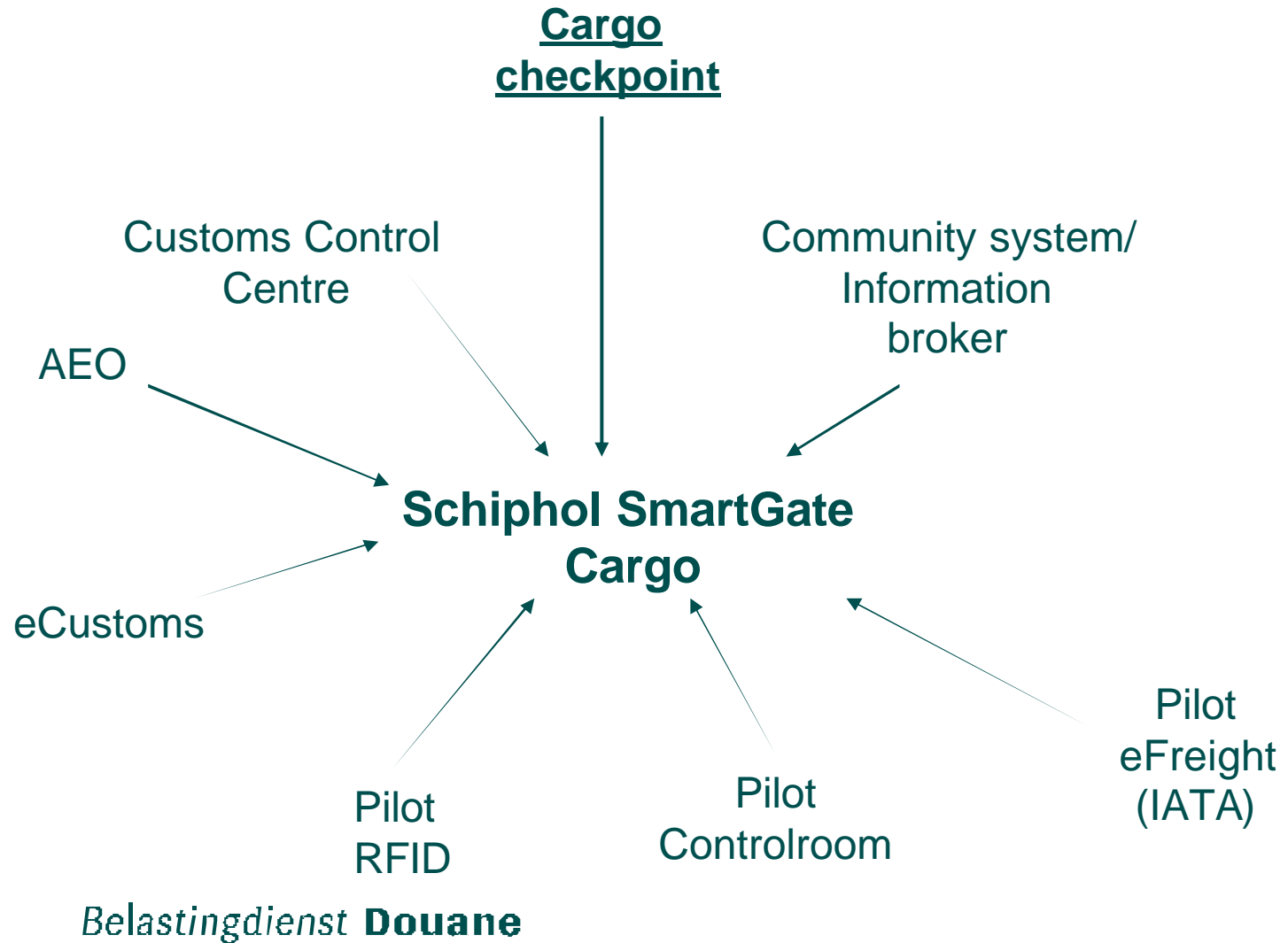

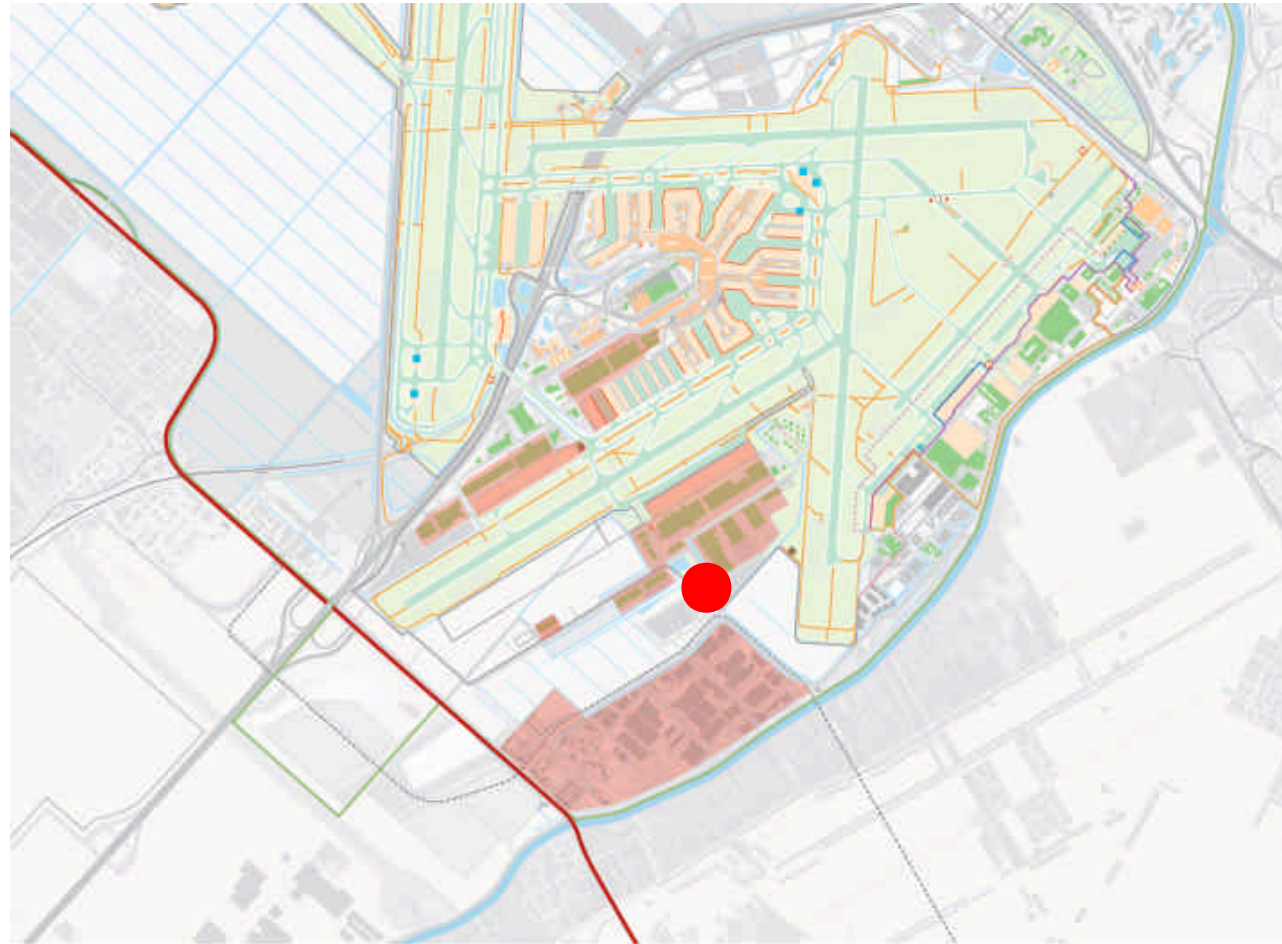
