**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE SIMPLIFICATION
AND HARMONIZATION OF CUSTOMS PROCEDURES
(AS AMENDED)**

(done at Kyoto on 18 May 1973,
amended on 3 February 2006)

NOTIFICATION BY JORDAN*

The Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan has notified the Secretary General, by a communication received on 8 December 2006, that Jordan has acceded to the International Convention on the simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures (as amended), done at Kyoto on 18 May 1973 and amended on 3 February 2006, and accepted, with reservations, the following Specific Annexes/Chapters :

Chapter 1 – Formalities prior to the lodgement of the Goods declaration (reservations against Recommended Practices 10, 11, 12 and 14)
Chapter 2 – Temporary storage of goods (reservations against Recommended Practices 10 and 11)

Chapter 1 - Clearance for home use
Chapter 3 - Relief from import duties and taxes
- **Specific Annex C – Exportation/**
Chapter 1 – Outright exportation
- **Specific Annex G – Temporary admission/**
Chapter 1 – Temporary admission (reservations against Recommended Practices 9, 21 and 23)
- **Specific Annex H – Offences/**
Chapter 1 – Customs offences
