About Us

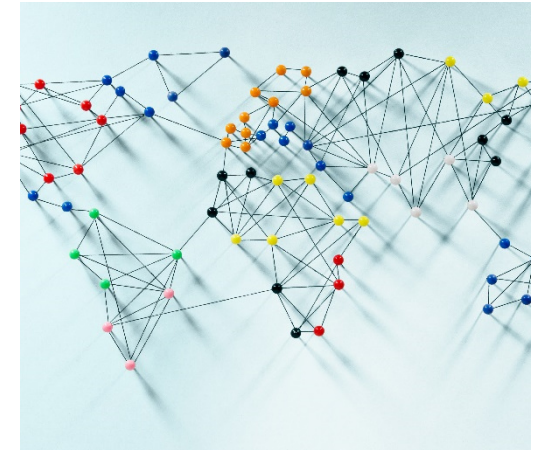

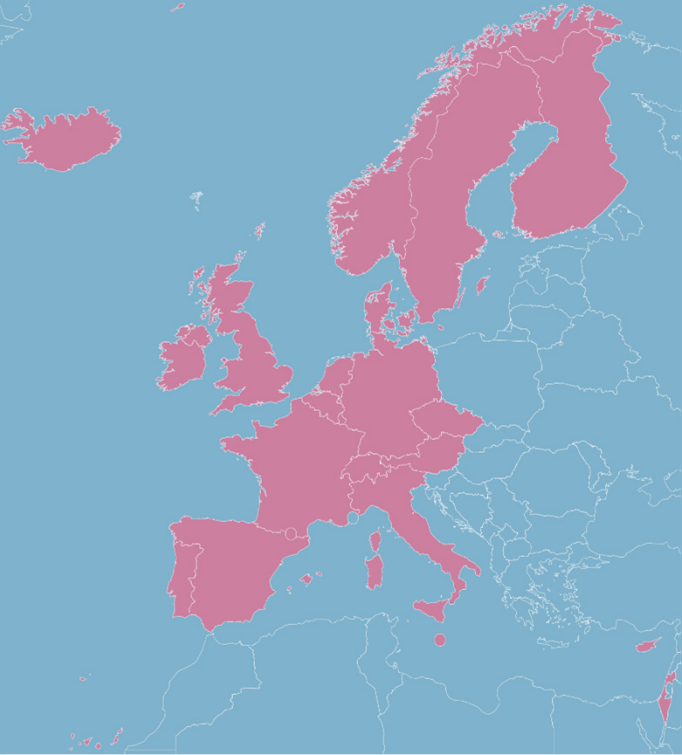

Our Mission

The RILO WE supports its member administrations by

- Organizing, coordinating and supporting (joint) Customs and Police operations

We are an active partner in projects, initiatives or priorities of the WCO and other international organizations/networks.



The RILO network uses the WCO CEN database and other sources to analyze seizures and develop regional intelligence products. The WCO CENcomm platform serves to exchange operational information and facilitate secure communications among members and partners.

WCO CEN and CENcomm

The WCO CEN (Customs Enforcement Network) database on customs seizures and criminal offences is necessary for the analysis of illicit trafficking in the various areas of Customs competence. Its functionalities enable users to retrieve data, which is crucial to defining strategies, preparing risk indicators, and identifying trends. Read-only access is available for all customs officers on request and approval.

The WCO CENcomm is a web based communication tool to exchange and disseminate information in a closed user group of officers to communicate via encrypted channels during operations or projects.
