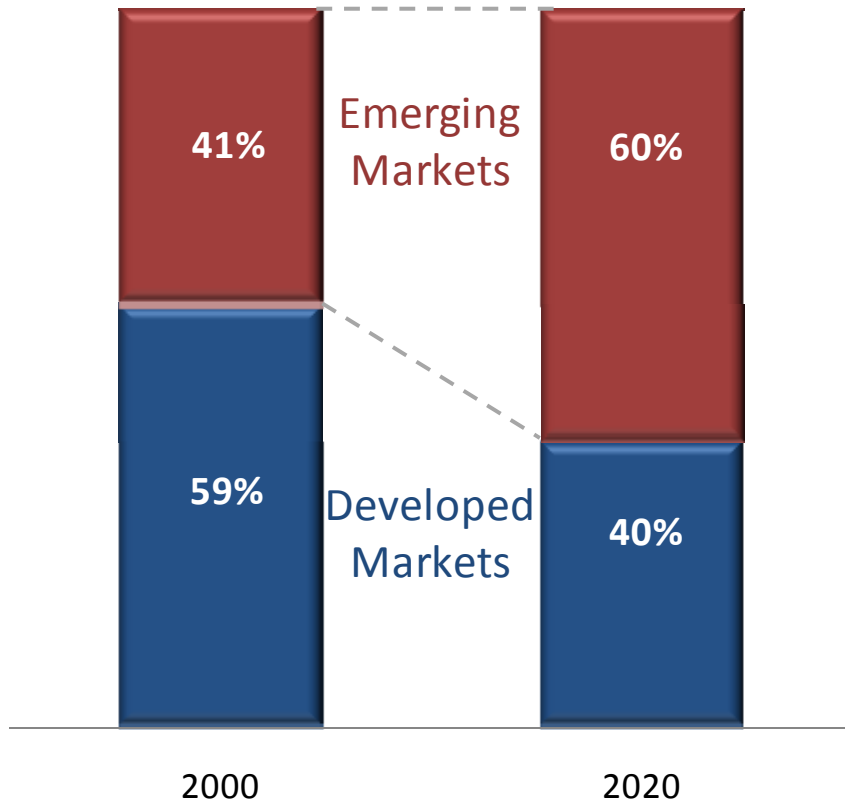

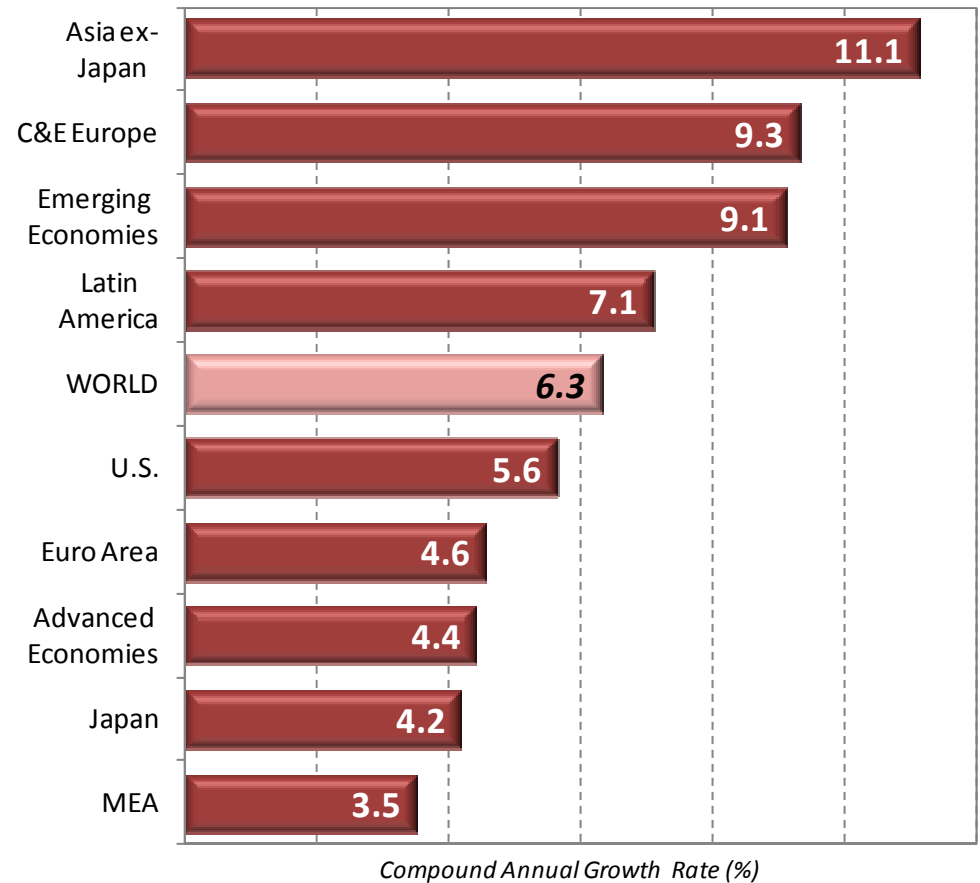
Emerging Markets are a Major Factor in Trade Growth Prospects
