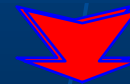
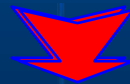
The WCO Mission Statement

High Priority Activities

- Trade Facilitation, smooth flow of goods
- Security of Global Supply Chains
- Cooperation among Customs and with other agencies, e.g. GNC, CBM, SW, MRA
- Efficiency of Customs, Use of modern tools and instruments

Key Requirements: Connectivity and Access to information when required



Potential Solutions

- More accurate data
- As early as possible
- Maximum use of risk management and reduced burden on trade
- Innovation (cloud? Data pipelines?)
- But there are concerns: data protection/confidentiality/ responsibility for accuracy of data
