- The only transit system with a **world-wide** coverage.
- TIR is an international transit system for **goods**.
- It can be applied for **multimodal transports** whenever one leg is carried out by road.



Improved cost effectiveness

- suppress national guarantees
- suppress involvement of third parties
- recognised in 57 countries
- speed-up border procedures



- IRU and UNCTAD signed a Memorandum of Understanding (27 April 2010) outlining areas of future cooperation between the two partner organisations

Controlled Access to TIR procedure

TIR is a privilege, not a right:

Access to TIR is reserved to transport operators meeting strict conditions and criteria set out in the TIR Convention, Annex 9, Part II:

- Sound financial standing
- Absence of Customs/fiscal offences
- Proven knowledge in the application of the TIR Convention
- Proven experience and capability to engage in international transport
- Written commitment to comply with Customs formalities and pay taxes and duties that would become due

Each actor of the TIR System plays a specific role involving particular responsibilities. Click on each actor, then on each tab to find out more about the responsibilities on these different fields.

Implementation of the TIR System Management of TIR operations Claims

- The application of the TIR Convention, designation of TIR customs offices, training of customs officials etc.
- Issuing the certificate of approval for vehicles by establishing or designating a national authority for the inspection and approval of road vehicles and containers.
- Establishing a 'guarantee' agreement between customs and the national association; insurance contract and insurance certificate.
- Controlling access to the TIR System: Providing & if necessary revoking authorisations to transporters eligible to use TIR Carnets.

The list above is not exhaustive but outlines the areas of expertise of each actor involved in the TIR System. All TIR actors must conform to all provisions of the TIR Convention.

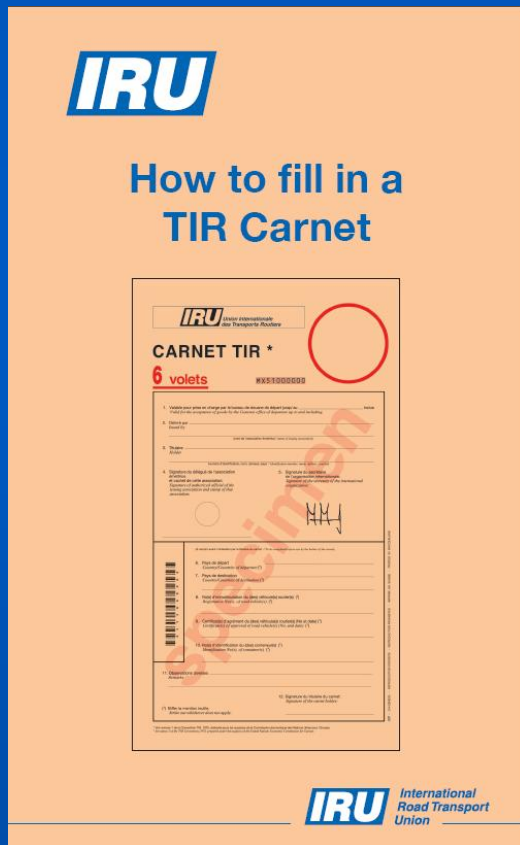
