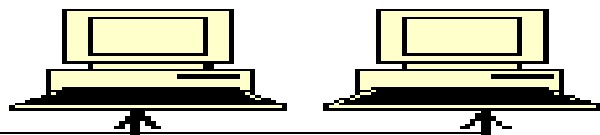

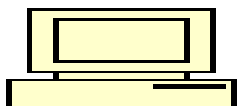
- Meeting agreed that:

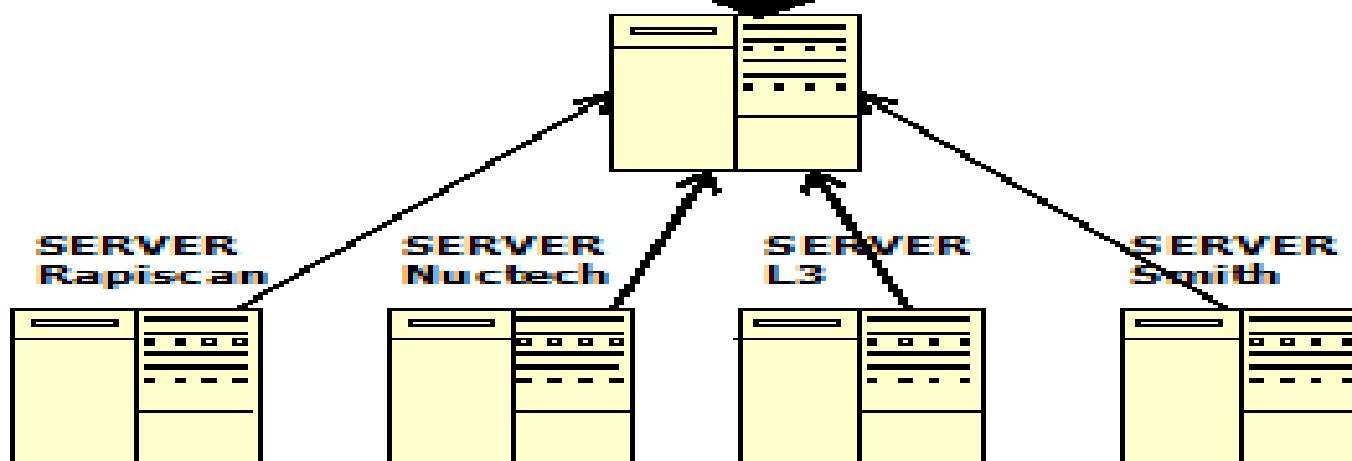
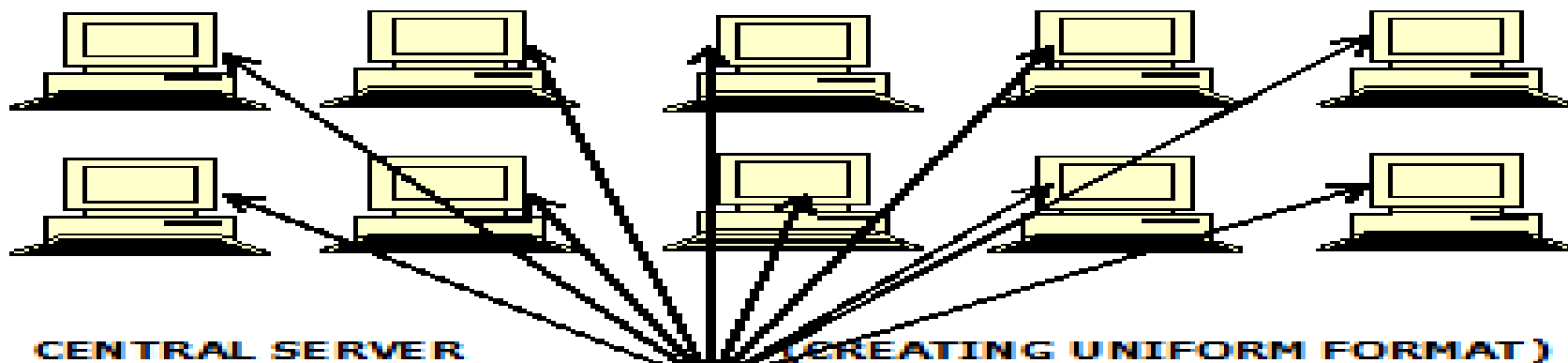


NEW SITUATION
