ECP PROGRESS REPORT

(Item III.e on the Agenda)

I. Background

1. The Economic Competitiveness Package (ECP) is designed to support the first pillar of the WCO Strategic Plan (Promote security and facilitation of international trade, including simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures). It comprises existing WCO tools and instruments which contribute to the enhancement of economic competitiveness by promoting trade facilitation while ensuring security of global supply chains. The principles laid down in the Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC) are recognized as the core of the ECP. The ECP includes all the other instruments, tools and standards relating to supply chain facilitation and security, such as the SAFE Framework of Standards (FoS), the Risk Management and Single Window Compendiums, and the Data Model.
2. In addition, the ECP may provide practical implementation guidance for the WTO Agreement on Trade Facilitation (TFA). For example, the WCO TFA Implementation Guide, an online Web tool for the harmonized and effective implementation of TFA provisions, is built on the ECP. In this regard, the scope of the ECP includes the TFA, and the ECP and the Mercator Programme reinforce each other.
3. The ECP also enables Members to promote regional integration. Referring to global standards defined by the RKC and other ECP tools and instruments, Customs administrations may harmonize various regulations and procedures in their regional or bilateral frameworks. For instance, the WCO Transit Handbook, which was added to the ECP in 2014, may serve as a practical guide to assist WCO Members in developing a functional and effective transit system that contributes to regional integration.

4. The first ECP Action Plan was endorsed at the Policy Commission's 68th Session in December 2012. It aimed to develop further instruments and tools which might contribute to the enhancement of economic competitiveness. Among the latest tools and instruments developed by the end of 2014 and endorsed by the WCO Council in 2015 are the following:
 - Transit Handbook
 - Model Business Lens Checklist for Small and Medium Sized Enterprises
 - Compendium on Coordinated Border Management
 - Customs-Business Partnership Guidance.
5. Awareness-raising was one of the most important parts of the first ECP Action Plan. Attention has been drawn to the ECP and relevant tools and instruments at more than 90 meetings and during regional workshops on the ECP in all six WCO regions. Useful materials have been developed, including the ECP Toolkit, the WTO Trade Facilitation Toolkit and the RKC Toolkit.

II. Progress in Implementation of the ECP Action Plan for Phase II

6. At the PTC sessions in October 2014, the ECP Action Plan for Phase II, covering the period from January 2015 to December 2016, was discussed and the revised Action Plan subsequently submitted to and endorsed by the Policy Commission in December 2014.
7. The ECP Action Plan for Phase II sets out 20 Actions, indicating deadlines where appropriate and the bodies responsible for the specific actions. The Secretariat has produced a table to show the progress made from January 2015 to 10 September 2015 in respect of each Action and that table is set out at the Annex hereto. In particular, major progress has been made in the following areas.

Awareness-Raising

8. Since January 2015, the ECP and relevant WCO tools have been promoted around 50 meetings by the WCO Secretariat. Regional Workshops on the Mercator Programme were organized in Indonesia, Hungary, Bahrain and Johannesburg to raise awareness of WCO tools for trade facilitation measures and share Members' experiences of the WTO TFA (two more remaining regional workshops will follow in October and November 2015 respectively).

Capacity Building Delivery

9. The WCO offers comprehensive tailor-made operational and technical support to implement ECP tools and instruments, based on Members' needs. So far in 2015 and at the time of writing this document, more than 50 National or Regional Workshops/Seminars have been organized to support Members with implementation of the WCO's existing instruments and tools under the ECP in various important areas such as the Time Release Study (TRS), Risk Management, Single Window and Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) programme. With respect to the RKC, the WCO has held eight National Workshops. Capacity Building activities under the ECP Action Plan form a mutually complementary relationship with the tailor-made track of the Mercator Programme.

Development and Elaboration of the ECP

10. Bearing in mind the ever-changing trade and business environment, regular updates of existing WCO tools and instruments and further development of new tools are to be expected. The development and elaboration of WCO tools and instruments under the ECP supports the overall track of the Mercator Programme.
11. In order to develop practical and useful instruments and tools for Members, innovative practices among Members will be collected and disseminated on a continuous basis. To collect Members' innovative practices, the Secretariat has conducted surveys on Post-Clearance Audit, TFA National Trade Facilitation Committees and Customs Brokers.
12. At the Council in June 2015, new tools and instruments such as the Customs-Business Partnership Guidance with its Advanced Pillar, the IT Guidance for Executives, the Voluntary Compliance Framework and the 2015 edition of the SAFE Framework of Standards were endorsed. In addition, the 2015 edition of the AEO Compendium has been published and the Guidelines for the Procurement and Deployment of Scanning/NII Equipment, including the Guidance Material on Threats and Technology Solutions, have been updated.

III. Action Required

13. The PTC is invited to take note of the progress made with the implementation of the ECP Action Plan for Phase II.
