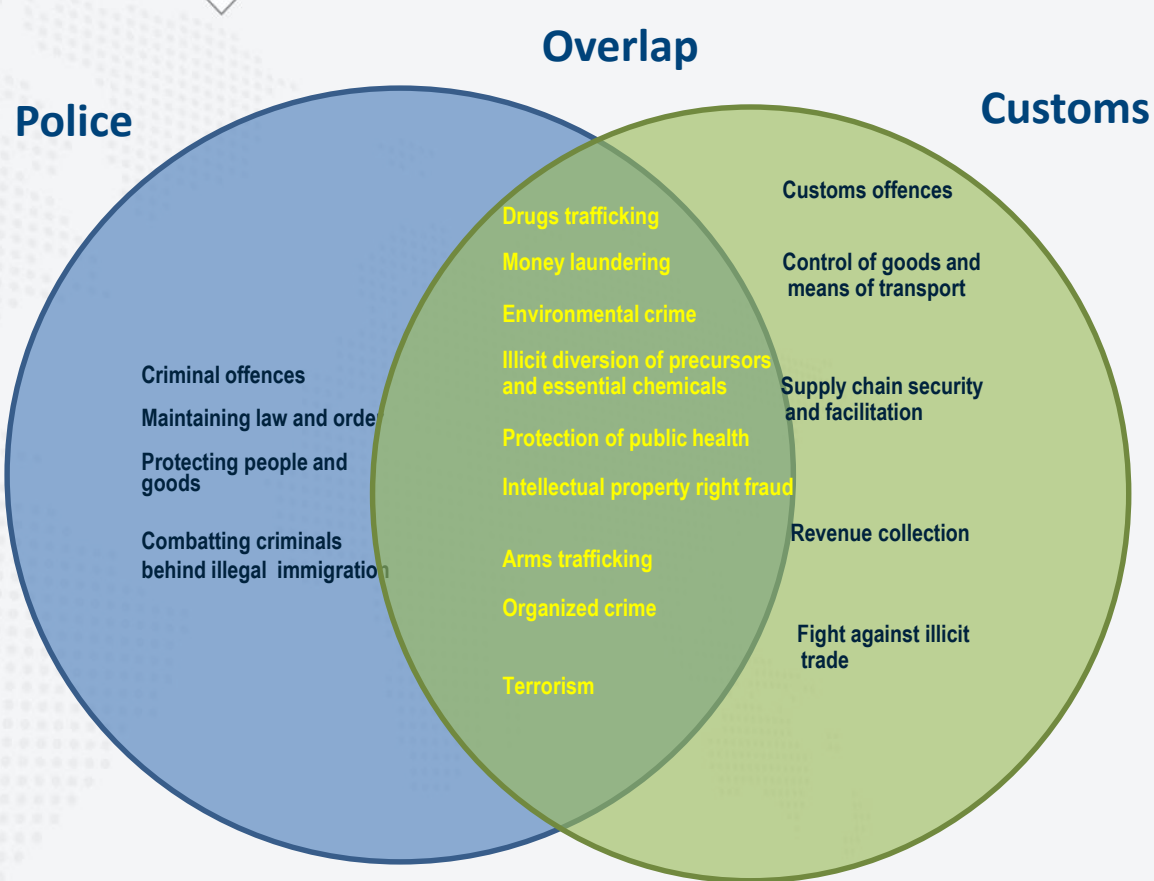

VI. Diagnostic tool

The diagnostic tool is supposed to be used as a guideline for member countries to assess the current situation on customs - police cooperation in order to start the process or to work on missing requirements.

The CPCH illustrates:

- advantages of a close cooperation,

- already existing international cooperation programmes,
- tools, databases and other policing capabilities of the both organizations (INTERPOL / WCO) to combat organized cross border crime,
