10.4 Single Window

Since 2011, the **Single Window** has been implemented in Mexico to facilitate the clearance of goods for import, export and transit, contributing to the facilitation, automation and improvement of processes through the use of information technologies. In addition, our country has been evaluated by important international organizations in this matter.

- Increases the country's competitiveness by simplifying, standardizing and automating trade processes
- Guarantees transparency, simplifies and enhances foreign trade operations
- It allows the transfer of advance information.
- It allows sending information electronically, on procedures of: 9 government agencies and 2 non-governmental organizations
