### **ARTICLE 11: FREEDOM OF TRANSIT**

The Head of Border management in Customs is the one who is appointed to be the coordinator of transit operations in Rwanda. Customs transit procedures in place does not allow any form of discrimination during transit operations from the first point of entry up to the Customs exit border and the Rwanda electronic Single Window system allows a Customs officer appointed at any exit country point to terminate a transit operation whenever it meets all transit requirements. The regional transit guarantee is applied thus to secure goods in transit.

Goods that are crossing the Rwandan territory under the transit regime are not subject to quality control and are not supposed to be compliant to quality standards at all.
