ARTICLE 9: MOVEMENT OF GOOD INTENDED FOR IMPORT UNDER CUSTOMS CONTROL

In case of import, the movement of goods from the Customs authority of entry to the Customs authority of destination located in its territory is regulated by Chapter 22 of the Eurasian Economic Union Customs Code, within the framework of the Customs procedure "Customs transit", in particular, according to part 3 of Article 142 of the Code, the Customs procedure "Customs transit" is applied in the case of goods transportation (transport transit):

- 1) from the Customs authority of the place of arrival to the Customs authority of the place of departure;
- 2) from the Customs authority of the place of arrival to the internal Customs authority;
- 3) from the internal Customs authority to the Customs authority of the place of departure;
- 4) from one internal Customs authority to another internal Customs authority;
- 5) between Customs authorities, through the territories of states that are not members of the Union and (or) by sea.
